3 Apr 23 1	1stBn, 6thMarReg, 2dMarDiv	At an Art. 16(c)(2)(A) special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
11 Apr 23 2	1stMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Private First Class C. S. Phillips, pursuant to the accused's plea, of the fraudulent use of an access device. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 215 days of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
12 Apr 23 3	II MEF	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
13 Apr 23 4	11thMarReg, 1stMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal E. SeverinoGonzalez, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of reckless driving and making a false official statement. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge and reduction to E-1.
14 Apr 23 5	3dMLG	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Butler, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
18 Apr 23 6	MCI-E	At an Art. 16(c)(2)(A) special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Gunnery Sergeant J. H. Bass of violation of a lawful general order. The military judge sentenced the accused to reduction to E-5 and a reprimand.
18 Apr 23 7	I MEF	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Gunnery Sergeant A. J. Williams, pursuant to the accused's plea, of knowingly receiving stolen property. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 30 days of confinement, and reduction to E-4.
19 Apr 23 8	1stMaintBn, 1stMLG	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal K. K. Schmidt, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of disorderly conduct and violation of a lawful general order. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 45 days of confinement and reduction to E-1.

20 Apr 23 9	MALS-39, MAG-39 3dMAW	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Miramar, a military judge convicted Private X. J. Lozada, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of assault, larceny, disrespect towards a noncommissioned officer, and willfully damaging military property. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge and 6 months of confinement.
20 Apr 23 10	2dMAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Recruit Depot Parris Island, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal G. L. Beckman, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of possession of child pornography. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 24 months of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
20 Apr 23 11	SecForBn Kings Bay	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Recruit Depot Parris Island, a military judge convicted Private I. M. Perez, pursuant to the accused plea, of burglary. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 6 months of confinement, and forfeiture of \$1,000 pay per month for 6 months.
26 Apr 23 12	7thEngSptBn, 1stMLG	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Sergeant Jonathan C. Puik, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of communicating a threat, aggravated assault with a loaded firearm, and domestic violence. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 12 months of confinement and reduction to E-1.
27 Apr 23 13	SptBn, RTR, MCRD-PI	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Recruit Depot Parris Island, a military judge convicted Private First Class D. E. Deremer of malingering and making a false official statement. The military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge and reduction to E-1.
