1 Nov 23 1	2d MarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal C. E. Robbins, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of conspiracy and negligent discharge of a firearm. The military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 120 days confinement, and reduction to E-1.
3 Nov 23 2	12th MCD, MCRD San Diego	At an Art. 16(c) (2) (A) special court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Miramar, a military judge convicted Sergeant K. T. Hayes of disobedience towards a noncommissioned officer. The military judge sentenced the accused to a reprimand.
6 Nov 23 3	MWSS-272	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Corporal M. S. Perkins, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of breach of the peace, battery, and unlawful entry. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 1 month of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
8 Nov 23 4	MCI-East	Following the previous conviction of Captain J. G. Gomezvillalobos at a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune for providing false official statements and conduct unbecoming an officer on 6 May 2021, the appellate court remanded the accused's sentence for a rehearing. At the rehearing, the military judge sentenced the accused to 2 months confinement.
8 Nov 23 5	7th Comm Bn	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Butler, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal P. A. Santos, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of wrongful use of a controlled substance and wrongful distribution of a controlled substance. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 90 days confinement, and reduction to E-1.
9 Nov 23 6	MARFORCYBER	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Quantico, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal J. C. Aragon, pursuant to the accused's plea, of sexual abuse of a child. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 8 years confinement, and reduction to E-1.
15 Nov 23 7	Training Command	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal D. D. Jacomeavila, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of providing a false official statement, obstructing

		justice, and negligent homicide. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 51 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
15 Nov 23 8	1st MLG	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a panel of members convicted Lance Corporal M. M. Salmon of abusive sexual contact and burglary with the intent to commit abusive sexual contact. The panel of members sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 3 years confinement, reduction to E-1, and a reprimand.
17 Nov 23 9	2d MarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal J. N. Morris, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of credit card fraud. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, forfeitures of \$876.00 for one month, and reduction to E-1.
20 Nov 23 10	7th ESB	At an Art. 16(c) (2) (A) special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Private M. I. Villanueva of failure to obey a lawful order. The military judge sentenced the accused to 30 days confinement, forfeitures of \$1,278 a month for one month, and a reprimand.
20 Nov 23 11	2d MLG	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal F. D. Bravosoriano, pursuant to the accused's plea, of distribution of a controlled substance. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge and reduction to E-1.
21 Nov 23 12	CLR-27	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Corporal D. A. Mix III, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of sexual abuse of a child. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge and 3 months of confinement.
22 Nov 23 13	Training Command	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Corporal E. L. Wright Jr., pursuant to the accused's pleas, of violating a lawful general order and larceny. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 75 days confinement, and reduction to E-1.
27 Nov 23 14	1st MarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal S. M. Small, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of abusive sexual contact. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 12 months confinement, total forfeitures, and reduction to E-1.
29 Nov 23 15	2d MAW	At a general court-martial held aboard Marine Corps Air Station Cherry Point, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal A. D. GarciaRuiz, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of possession of child pornography. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge

		sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 20 months confinement, and reduction to E-1.
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
