SUBJECT: Evaluation of Land-based Security Controls for Equipment Being Transferred to
Ukraine (Project No. D2023-DEV0PC-0066.000)

We plan to begin the subject evaluation in January 2023. The objective of this evaluation is to determine the extent to which the DoD implemented security controls for multimodal cargo headed to Ukraine via land-based means in the U.S. European Command area of responsibility in accordance with the Defense Transportation Regulation and DoD policies. We will perform the evaluation at the Poland logistics hub in Zamość, Poland and Headquarters, U.S. Army Europe and Africa, Germany. We may identify additional locations during the evaluation.
