1 Nov 22 1	MWHS-2, 2dMAW	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Cherry Point, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal C. C. Hunt Jr., pursuant to the accused's pleas, of larceny and making false official statements. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, forfeiture of 2/3 pay for 1 month, and reduction to E-1.
3 Nov 22 2	2dReconBn, 2dMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Staff Sergeant J. A. Rangel, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of abuse of position as a military recruiter. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge and reduction to E-3.
4 Nov 22 3	MCAS Miramar	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Miramar, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
5 Nov 22 4	2dMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Private First Class D. G. Hotz III, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of possessing child pornography and desertion. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 22 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
7 Nov 22 5	1stMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Staff Sergeant M. J. Bernal, pursuant to the accused's plea, of possessing child pornography. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 24 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
8 Nov 22 6	HqSptBn, MCI-E	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Private First Class T. T. Campbell of willful dereliction of duty and reckless driving. The military judge sentenced the accused to 28 days of confinement and reduction to E-1.
8 Nov 22 7	3dMAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station, Miramar, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal A. M. Bertram, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of viewing and possessing child pornography, and a violation of a lawful general order. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 26 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.

9 Nov 22 8	AITBn, SOI-W, Trng Cmd	At an Art. 16(c)(2)(A) special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Sergeant H. Kukharau of assault consummated by battery. The military judge awarded no punishment.
12 Nov 22 9	MACG-18, 1stMAW	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Butler, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
16 Nov 22 10	MCRD San Deigo	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Corporal N. M. LozanoSanchez, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of willfully disobeying a superior commissioned officer and domestic violence. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 6 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
16 Nov 22 11	3dLCT, 3dMLR, 3dMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a military judge convicted Private First Class E. B. Tapp, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of communicating a threat and breaking restriction. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 80 days of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
16 Nov 22 12	H&SBn, SOI-W, Trng Cmd	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal S. J. Hernandez, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of unauthorized absence and larceny. The accused elected sentencing by members; the members sentenced the accused to 3 months of confinement, forfeiture of \$1,222 pay per month for 12 months, and reduction to E-1.
17 Nov 22 13	1stBn, 5thMar, 1stMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal R. A. Hernandez, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of larceny. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 7 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
17 Nov 22 14	1stMAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Butler, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal A. E. Rankin, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of possession of child pornography. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 50 months of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
18 Nov 22 15	MCAS Miramar	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Miramar, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal O. L. Grey, pursuant to the accused's plea, of assault on an intimate partner by strangulation. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 10 months of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.

<p>18 Nov 22 16</p>	<p>HqSptBn, SOI-W, Trng Cmd</p>	<p>At an Art. 16(c)(2)(A) special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal K. N. Hoopii Jr., pursuant to the accused's pleas, of larceny. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 4 months of confinement, forfeiture of \$610 pay per month for 4 months, and reduction to E-1.</p>
<p>21 Nov 22 17</p>	<p>3dMLR, 3dMarDiv</p>	<p>At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal C. J. Jacobs, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of conspiracy and wrongful use and distribution of a controlled substance. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 11 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.</p>
<p>22 Nov 22 18</p>	<p>CLR-3, 3dMLG</p>	<p>At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Butler, a military judge convicted Corporal J. M. Benavidez Jr., pursuant to the accused's plea, of indecent conduct. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 90 days of confinement, forfeiture of 2/3 pay per month for 12 months, and reduction to E-1.</p>
