



Project Location





Project Background

- Navy Region Southwest San Diego Bay Eelgrass Mitigation Bank (Bank) created in 2008
- Navy projects may result in unavoidable impacts to aquatic habitat
- Navy offsets impacts to aquatic habitat using the Bank
- Bank expansion is needed to support Navy mission-critical projects



Existing Eelgrass Bank Sites





Purpose and Need

- The <u>purpose</u> of the Proposed Action is to support Navy mission requirements while ensuring the continued commitment to conservation of the San Diego Bay ecosystem.
- The Proposed Action is <u>needed</u> to facilitate implementation of future Navy projects and activities in San Diego Bay that may have the potential to impact eelgrass habitat.



Proposed Action

- The Navy proposes to add to the existing Eelgrass Mitigation Bank by expanding eelgrass habitat at one or more sites in San Diego Bay
- The Proposed Action consists of:
 - Site selection
 - Site establishment
 - Planting of eelgrass shoots
 - Monitoring, maintenance, and reporting
 - Adding credit to the Bank

About Eelgrass

- Eelgrass is a type of seagrass
- Eelgrass found in San Diego Bay consists of two species
 - Common eelgrass(Zostera marina)
 - Pacific eelgrass (Z. pacifica)
- Eelgrass is an important and productive habitat in San Diego Bay
- Eelgrass meadows serve as important nursery areas for numerous fish and invertebrate species





Project Alternatives

- Navy initially identified 17 potential eelgrass sites
- Applied three screening factors
 - 1. Compatibility with Navy Training/Testing
 - 2. Compatibility with Public Land Uses
 - 3. Suitable Physical Conditions
- Navy coordinated internally with Navy operational commands and externally with the Port of San Diego and federal agencies
- Four sites grouped into three alternatives carried forward for analysis in Draft EA




Site Alternatives





Alternative 1 – Ballast Point


- Ballast Point
 - 10.1-acre site
 - No fill of suitable dredged material required
 - Plant *Pacific* eelgrass shoots
 - Bank Yield: ~8.5 acres





Alternative 2 – Delta Beach to Homeport Island/Homeport Island Submerged Plateau


- Delta Beach to Homeport Island (2A)
 - 9.0-acre site
 - ~63,000 CY of suitable dredged material required
 - Plant common eelgrass shoots
 - Bank Yield: ~7.0 acres





Alternative 2 – Delta Beach to Homeport Island/Homeport Island Submerged Plateau


- Homeport Island
 Submerged Plateau (2B)
 - 13.0-acre site
 - ~95,000 CY of suitable dredge material required
 - Plant common eelgrass shoots
 - Bank Yield: ~12.6 acres





Alternative 3 – South Silver Strand

- South Silver Strand
 - 10.0-acre site
 - ~130,000 CY of suitable dredged material required
 - Plant common eelgrass shoots
 - Bank Yield: ~9.8 acres





No Action Alternative

- Would not create additional eelgrass habitat in San Diego Bay
- Would not provide ecological benefits or add to the Bank
- Would not meet the purpose and need for the Proposed Action
- Provides a baseline for measuring environmental consequences of the Proposed Action



Resource Areas Analyzed

- Resource Areas Dismissed from Detailed Analysis:
 - Air Quality, Geological Resources, Cultural Resources, Visual Resources, Airspace, Noise, Infrastructure, Transportation, Public Health and Safety, Hazardous Materials and Wastes, Socioeconomics, and Environmental Justice
- Resource Areas Analyzed in Detail:
 - Marine Water Resources and Bathymetry
 - Marine Biological Resources
 - Land Use





Draft EA Findings

- Less than significant impacts to all resource areas
- Some short-term adverse impacts to marine water quality and some marine species; however, overall long-term beneficial impacts to most resource areas
- Compatible with existing military and public land use
- Navy may select one or more alternatives for implementation



Resource Agency Consultations & Final EA and Decision Document

- The Navy is coordinating/consulting with the following:
 - Port of San Diego, California Coastal
 Commission, National Marine Fisheries Service,
 U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service
- The Navy will integrate the outcome of coordination/consultation into the Final EA
- The Navy will publish the Final EA and decision document
