## **PFA RESET**

## NAVADMIN 042/23 - FACT SHEET

The Navy announced a one-time reset of physical fitness assessment failures for all active and reserve Sailors, empowering Commanding Officers to restore their personnel's retention and advancement recommendations to allow those Sailors to reenlist, advance, promote, negotiate for orders, or execute other career continuation transitions such as extensions and duty station transfers.



## STA-21 PROGRAM ANNOUNCEMENT

## NAVADMIN 044/23 • FACT SHEET

The STA-21 Program is a commissioning program for active duty enlisted Sailors. The application process opens in February and closes on July 1, 2023. Selected candidates attend the Naval Science Institute in Newport, R.I., and go on to attend college at an NROTC affiliated university. They receive \$10,000 per year, have 36 months to complete their degree, and receive a commission as an Ensign upon graduation.
