2 Feb 23 1	MARSOC	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Cherry Point, a panel of members convicted Gunnery Sergeant J. S. Negron of violating a lawful general order. The members sentenced the accused to no punishment.
2 Feb 23 2	MARSOC	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Cherry Point, a panel of members convicted Gunnery Sergeant D. A. Draher Jr. of violating a lawful general order. The members sentenced the accused to no punishment.
14 Feb 23 3	1stMLG	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Sergeant B. L. Valdez Jr., pursuant to the accused's pleas, of domestic violence. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 3 years of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
16 Feb 23 4	MCESG, MCB Quantico	At an Art. 16(c)(2)(A) special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Quantico, a military judge convicted Private S. R. McDonald, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of wrongful use of a controlled substance. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 78 days of confinement.
22 Feb 23 5	1stMaintBn, 1stMLG	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Yuma, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal E. ReyesAndrade, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of wrongful use of a controlled substance. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 90 days of confinement, forfeiture of \$1,585 pay per month for 3 months, and reduction to E-1.
25 Feb 23 6	MACG-28, 2dMAW	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Cherry Point, a military judge convicted Staff Sergeant G. Cortez, pursuant to the accused pleas, of violating a lawful general order and willfully disobeying a superior commissioned officer. The military judge sentenced the accused to reduction to E-2.
