4 Jan 23 1	3dMAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal A. W. Kirkpatrick, pursuant to the accused's plea, of possession of child pornography. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 26 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
4 Jan 23 2	RTR, MCRD Parris Island	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Recruit Depot Parris Island, a military judge convicted Staff Sergeant J. M. Colletti, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of violation of a lawful general order, obstruction of justice, and wire fraud. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, forfeiture of \$1,278 pay per month for 12 months, and reduction to E-1.
11 Jan 23 3	1stRadBn, I MIG, I MEF	At an Art. 16(c) (2) (A) special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
11 Jan 23 4	1stMAW	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Iwakuni, a military judge convicted Corporal E. P. Vasquez, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of damaging non-military property, larceny, and domestic violence. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 4 months of confinement, forfeiture of \$1,278 pay per month for 4 months, and reduction to E-1.
12 Jan 23 5	1stRadBn, I MIG, I MEF	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Gunnery Sergeant T. S. Craig, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of wrongful introduction, possession, and use of controlled substances. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 120 days confinement and a reduction to E-5.
12 Jan 23 6	III MIG, III MEF	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Butler, a panel of members convicted Lance Corporal R. Tarin III, of drunken operation of a vehicle, wrongful appropriation of a vehicle, fleeing the scene of an accident, unlawful entry, and assault consummated by battery. The accused elected sentencing by military judge; the military judge sentenced the accused to 5 months of confinement, forfeiture of \$1,278 pay per month for 3 months, and reduction to E-1.
18 Jan 23 7	TrngCmd	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.

18 Jan 23 8	H&HSBn, MCAS Beaufort	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Recruit Depot Parris Island, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal S. P. Rosberg, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of knowingly using a credit or debit card without authorization to obtain property. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 85 days of confinement, forfeiture of \$1,601.42 pay per month for 12 months, and reduction to E-1.
19 Jan 23 9	WRR, MCRD San Diego	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Miramar, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal Y. R. Acosta-Fierros, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of assault consummated by battery. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 7 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
19 Jan 23 10	TrngCmd	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Quantico, a military judge convicted Sergeant J. D. Witkowski, pursuant to the accused's plea, of possession of child pornography. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 40 months of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
26 Jan 23 11	3dMLG	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Butler, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal S. N. Kapayou, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of possession of child pornography and viewing child pornography. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 20 months of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
27 Jan 23 12	2dMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a panel of members convicted Corporal J. O. RosarioMartinez of sexual assault. The members sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge and 18 months of confinement.
27 Jan 23 13	HqSptBn, MCI-W	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Private J. T. Barmeyer, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of assault upon a law enforcement officer. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 90 days of confinement.
27 Jan 23 14	1stMAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
30 Jan 23 15	CLR-37, 3dMLG	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Butler, a military judge convicted Corporal N. L. Garner, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of domestic violence. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 6 months of confinement, forfeiture of \$1,278 pay per month for 6 months, and reduction to E-1.

31 Jan 23 16	3dMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Butler, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal E. M. Bodestyne, pursuant to the accused's plea, of communicating a threat. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 192 days of confinement and reduction to E-1.
31 Jan 23 17	TrngCmd	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Quantico, a military judge convicted Private J. A. Aguilar, pursuant to the accused's plea, of assault consummated by battery. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused a bad conduct discharge.
