SUBJECT: Audit of Naval Facilities Engineering Command Military Construction Projects  
(Project No. D2023-D000AV-0123.000)

The purpose of this memorandum is to notify you that we plan to begin the subject audit in May 2023. The objective of this audit is to determine why the U.S. Naval Facilities Engineering Command had cost increases or schedule delays of Navy and Marine Corps military construction projects and what actions the U.S. Naval Facilities Engineering Command took to mitigate future cost increases and schedule delays. We may revise the objective as the audit proceeds, and we will also consider suggestions from management for additional or revised objectives. We plan to perform this audit in accordance with the Government Accountability Office's generally accepted government auditing standards.

We will perform the audit within the Naval Facilities Engineering Command Atlantic and Pacific command locations. We may identify additional locations during the audit.

We request that you designate a staff member to serve as our point of contact for this audit within **5 days** of this memorandum. The point of contact should be a Government employee—a GS-15, pay band equivalent, or military equivalent—and knowledgeable of the military construction related to the objective.
