Former Long Beach Naval Station and Shipyard, Long Beach, CA
Notice of Basewide Five-Year Review
Installation Restoration Sites 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6A, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, and 14



October 2023

The United States Department of the Navy (Navy) is the lead agency implementing Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA) environmental cleanup activities (remedies) at the former Naval Station Long Beach and the former Long Beach Naval Shipyard, the “Long Beach Naval Complex” (LBNC) in Long Beach, California. This notice informs the public that the Navy is currently conducting a Five-Year Review (5YR) at the LBNC. The LBNC is located on Terminal Island between the City of Long Beach and the San Pedro District of the City of Los Angeles. The Navy is conducting the 5YR in accordance with the requirements of CERCLA Section 121(c). The purpose of the 5YR is to determine whether the remedies selected in Record of Decision (ROD) documents remain protective of human health and the environment. CERCLA requires a review every five years for remedies that leave contaminants in place at cleanup sites above levels that allow for unrestricted reuse. The Navy will conduct a 5YR of the remedies implemented at LBNC under CERCLA for Installation Restoration (IR) Sites 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6A, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13 and 14.

The remedies at these IR Sites were implemented to address chemicals of concern in soil, sediment, soil gas, and/or groundwater that pose potentially unacceptable risk to human health and the environment. The remedies include soil removal, soil covers, groundwater treatment and/or monitoring, soil vapor extraction and monitoring, and institutional controls. The 5YR report will provide an update to the status of remedial actions since the previous 5YR report (2019) and assess progress made on the recommendations in the 2019 5YR report.

A draft of the 5YR Report will be made available for public review and comment. The Navy will issue a public notice when the 5YR Report has been finalized, anticipated December 2024.
