The purpose of this memorandum is to notify you that we plan to begin the subject evaluation in September 2023. The objective of this evaluation is to assess the effectiveness of the DoD's support for the development of operational logistics and sustainment capabilities for the Iraqi Security Forces (ISF). We may revise the objective as the evaluation proceeds, and we will also consider suggestions from management for additional or revised objectives. We plan to perform this evaluation in accordance with Council of the Inspectors General on Integrity and Efficiency, "Quality Standards for Inspection and Evaluation."

We will perform the evaluation via virtual or in-person interviews at the the Pentagon, Arlington, VA; MacDill Air Force Base, Tampa, Florida; and Camp Arifjan, Kuwait. We may identify additional locations during the evaluation.

We request that you designate a staff member to serve as our point of contact for this evaluation within **5 days** of this memorandum. The point of contact should be a Government employee—a GS-15, pay band equivalent, or military equivalent—and knowledgeable of the Combined Joint Task Force-Operation Inherent Resolve Campaign Plan and any DoD activities that relate to the objective. Send the contact's name, title, grade/pay band, phone number, and email address to [REDACTED] and [REDACTED].
