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The District Engineer, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, New England District (USACE), has received a permit application, file number NAE-2021-02240, to conduct work in waters of the United States from Granite State Landfill, LLC, 1855 Vermont Route 100, Hyde Park, Vermont, 05655. This work is proposed in unnamed wetlands and unnamed tributaries to Alder Brook and Ammonoosuc River at 172 Douglas Drive, Bethlehem, New Hampshire. The site coordinates are: Latitude 44.331N Longitude – 71.695.

The project proposes the construction of a double-lined commercial landfill in Dalton, New Hampshire. The landfill footprint encompasses 70 acres and will provide 18 years of disposal capacity, accepting 600,000 cubic yards of waste per year. Work includes constructing the landfill cells, clearing and grubbing, soil excavation and fill placement, new roadways, improvements to existing roadways including road improvements to Douglas Drive and Route 116, landfill infrastructure to include landfill gas management area, a wastewater management area, stormwater management features, scales, buildings, and other ancillary features.

The USACE has authority under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act (CWA), to regulate the discharge of fill into waters of the United States which does not include trash or garbage (33 CFR 323.2 (e)(3)). If the proposed infrastructure used to construct the landfill has the effect of filling jurisdictional waters, the infrastructure would be considered "fill material" for the purposes of Section 404. However, any subsequent disposal of solid waste into the landfill and/or discharges of leachate from the landfill are not within the USACE's jurisdiction to regulate and are therefore not part of our permit review. Solid waste and discharges of leachate are regulated pursuant to the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) and Section 402 of the CWA known as the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES). The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is the federal agency responsible for the administration of RCRA and the Section 402 NPDES program. The EPA sets criteria for the operation of landfills and discharges which the individual states implement, however, the states may also set more stringent requirements. Discharge of leachate from the landfill into waters of the United States would be regulated under Section 402 of the CWA and not USACE's Section 404 program.

Permanent impacts to wetlands and waters of the United States (WOTUS) include approximately 10.19 acres to wetlands and 1,518 linear feet of stream impact for the construction of the landfill and associated infrastructure improvements. Temporary impacts for the project include 0.49 acres to wetlands and 1,628 linear feet of stream impact. Additionally, 0.85 acres of wetland impact and 110 linear feet of stream impact

are included for impacts that occurred along the existing roadway prior to Granite State Landfill's involvement with the site.

The work is shown on the enclosed plans titled "Granite State Landfill, LLC- Granite State Landfill, Dalton, New Hampshire-Permitting Plan Set," on 50 sheets, and dated "October 2023."

The Granite State Landfill has been designed to avoid and minimized environmental impacts while providing future disposal capacity for municipalities and customers currently directing waste to the North Country Environmental Services, Inc while also providing a disposal resource for other waste generators in New Hampshire and New England. To compensate for the project's projected impacts to waterways and wetlands, the applicant is currently proposing a contribution to the State of New Hampshire Aquatic Resource Mitigation Fund (NH In Lieu Fee Program), and permittee responsible restoration and/or land preservation.

#### **AUTHORITY**

Permits are required pursuant to:

- Section 10 of the Rivers and Harbors Act of 1899
- Section 404 of the Clean Water Act
- Section 103 of the Marine Protection, Research and Sanctuaries Act.
- Section 14 of the Rivers and Harbors Act of 1899 (33 USC 408)

The decision whether to issue a permit will be based on an evaluation of the probable impact of the proposed activity on the public interest. That decision will reflect the national concern for both protection and utilization of important resources. The benefit which may reasonably accrue from the proposal must be balanced against its reasonably foreseeable detriments. All factors which may be relevant to the proposal will be considered, including the cumulative effects thereof; among those are: conservation, economics, aesthetics, general environmental concerns, wetlands, cultural value, fish and wildlife values, flood hazards, flood plain value, land use, navigation, shoreline erosion and accretion, recreation, water supply and conservation, water quality, energy needs, safety, food production and, in general, the needs and welfare of the people.

#### **NATIONAL HISTORIC PRESERVATION ACT**

Based on our initial review of the proposed project, historic properties were identified within the area of potential effects. However, the applicant currently proposes to avoid all effects to known historic properties. Additional review and consultation to fulfil requirements under Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966, as

amended, will be ongoing as part of the permit review process.

### **ENDANGERED SPECIES CONSULTATION**

The USACE is reviewing the application for the potential impact on federally-listed threatened or endangered species and their designated critical habitat pursuant to section 7 of the Endangered Species Act as amended. Our review will be concluded prior to the final decision.

### **OTHER GOVERNMENT AUTHORIZATIONS**

The following authorizations have been applied for, or have been, or will be obtained:

- (X) Permit, license or assent from State.
- (X) Permit from local wetland agency or conservation commission.
- (X) Water Quality Certification in accordance with Section 401 of the Clean Water Act.

### **COMMENTS**

The Corps of Engineers is soliciting comments from the public; Federal, state, and local agencies and officials; Indian Tribes; and other interested parties in order to consider and evaluate the impacts of this proposed activity. Any comments received will be considered by the Corps of Engineers to determine whether to issue, modify, condition or deny a permit for this proposal. To make this decision, comments are used to assess impacts on endangered species, historic properties, water quality, general environmental effects, and the other public interest factors listed above. Comments are used in the preparation of an Environmental Assessment and/or an Environmental Impact Statement pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act. Comments are also used to determine the need for a public hearing and to determine the overall public interest of the proposed activity. People submitting comments are advised that all comments received will be available for public review in their entirety and will be considered a matter of public record.

The USACE holds public hearings for the purpose of obtaining public comments when that is the best means for understanding a wide variety of concerns from a diverse segment of the public.





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## General Construction Sequence Notes:

- coverage under EPA's Construction General Permit and implement Swapping training

2. Complete OSHA notifications (311 or 888-GO-SAFE).

3. Establish hearing and vehicle centre.

4. Site mobilization.

5. Initial perimeter controls, including all fencing, permanent stock pile, and EBM. Erosion controls shall be installed throughout construction.

6. Construct stormwater control system, minimum point protection, and swales. Tuning to the well to minimize runoff potential. Anytime a trench greater than 10' deep is dug, a soil test is required. An Environmental Monitor must be present on site during trenching operations. Trenching is controlled by Section 1926.650 (D) of the Act Rules.

7. Construct improvements at the entrance onto Route 116.

8. Construct improvements to Douglas Drive.

9. Construct internal roads, infrastructure areas, Stage 1. (i.e. paved roads) and turn around construction.

10. Installation of temporary and final gas coverage and other utilities.



Primary & Secondary Pump Station




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
**Typical Liner Section (Base Areas)**


**Typical Liner Section (Slope Areas)**




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


**Cell Diversion Berm - Pipe Penetration**


**Capping System Tie-in at Anchor Trench**








