SUBJECT: Audit of U.S. European Command Force Protection Measures at Installations
in Poland that Support Operation Atlantic Resolve
(Project No. D2024-D000RH-0101.000)

The purpose of this memorandum is to notify you that we plan to begin the subject audit in March 2024.

The objective of this audit is to determine whether the DoD implemented force protection measures at U.S. European Command installations in Poland in support of Operation Atlantic Resolve in accordance with DoD policy. We may revise the objective as the audit proceeds, and we will also consider suggestions from management for additional or revised objectives. We plan to perform this audit in accordance with the Government Accountability Office's generally accepted government auditing standards.

We will perform this audit at Life Support Area Eagle located at Rzeszow-Jasionka Airport in Poland. We may identify additional locations during the audit.

We request that you designate a staff member to serve as our point of contact for this audit within **5 days** of this memorandum. The point of contact should be a Government employee—a GS-15, pay band equivalent, or military equivalent—and knowledgeable of mitigating force protection weaknesses related to the objective. Send the contact's name, title, grade/pay band, phone number, and email address to audrgo@dodig.mil.
