SUBJECT: Audit of the Impact of Continuing Resolutions on DoD Acquisition Programs
(Project No. D2024-D000AU-0112.000)

The purpose of this memorandum is to notify you that we plan to begin the subject audit in April 2024. The objective of this audit is to determine DoD's ability to effectively manage acquisition programs during continuing resolutions. We may revise the objective as the audit proceeds, and we will also consider suggestions from management for additional or revised objectives. We plan to perform this audit in accordance with the Government Accountability Office's generally accepted government auditing standards.

We will perform the audit at the Office of the Under Secretary of Defense for Acquisition and Sustainment, Office of the Under Secretary of Defense (Comptroller)/Chief Financial Officer, Offices of the Service Acquisition Executives, and selected DoD Program Executive Offices. We may identify additional locations during the audit.

We request that you designate a staff member to serve as our point of contact for this audit within **5 days** of this memorandum. The point of contact should be a Government employee—a GS-15, pay band equivalent, or military equivalent—and knowledgeable about the impacts continuing resolutions have on DoD acquisition programs and the DoD's efforts to mitigate these impacts, as related to the objective.
