4 Jun 24 1	1st MARDIV	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Corporal D. P. Sullivan, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of domestic violence - commission of a violent offense. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 90 days of confinement, a reduction to E-1, and a bad conduct discharge.
7 Jun 24 2	3d MAW	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Miramar, a military judge convicted Corporal D. M. Ongsing of a violation of a lawful general order. The military judge sentenced the accused to a reduction to E-3.
12 Jun 24 3	II MEF	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Corporal D. K. Romero of larceny of non-military property of a value of \$1,000 or less, assault consummated by a battery, and indecent conduct. The military judge sentenced the accused to eight months of confinement, a reduction to E-1, and a bad conduct discharge.
12 Jun 24 4	MCAS Cherry Point	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Cherry Point, a military judge acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
12 Jun 24 5	1st MARDIV	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Private First Class S. D. Bolton, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of domestic violence - commission of a violent offense and fleeing apprehension. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 12 months of confinement, and a reduction to E-1, and a bad conduct discharge.
12 Jun 24 6	4th MAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Forces Reserve, New Orleans, Louisiana, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
13 Jun 24 7	MCRD San Diego	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
14 Jun 24 8	1st MARDIV	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
14 Jun 24 9	TRNG CMD	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Private M. A. Abney, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of assault consummated by a battery, abusive sexual contact, and three specifications of a violation of a lawful general order. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 33 months of confinement, total forfeitures, and a bad conduct discharge.

17 Jun 24 10	TRNG CMD	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Private D. D. Wilson, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of two specifications of abusive sexual contact, indecent conduct, assault consummated by a battery, and four specifications of a violation of a lawful general order. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 53 months of confinement, total forfeitures, and a dishonorable discharge.
21 Jun 24 11	2d MARDIV	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal J. P. Whitmore, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of domestic violence - commission of a violent offense and domestic violence - a violation of a protection order with intent to threaten or intimidate. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a reduction to E-1.
21 Jun 24 12	II MEF	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal C. M. Lamb, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of a violation of a lawful general order and conspiracy to commit assault consummated by a battery. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 89 days of confinement, total forfeitures, a reduction to E-1, and a bad conduct discharge.
27 Jun 24 13	TRNG CMD	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Quantico, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal N. H. Jones, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of domestic violence - commission of a violent offense. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 150 days of confinement, and a bad conduct discharge.
27 Jun 24 14	1st MARDIV	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, California, a military judge acquitted a Sergeant of all charges and specifications.
