1 Dec 23 1	MALS-24	At special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a military judge convicted Sergeant S. C. Gaspar, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of attempted fraudulent use of a credit card and fraudulent use of a debit card. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 2 months confinement, and reduction to E-1.
1 Dec 23 2	2d MarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal M. A. LopezMartinez, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of providing a false official statement. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused 15 days confinement and reduction to E-2.
4 Dec 23 3	Trng Cmd	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Quantico, a military judge convicted Gunnery Sergeant R. Alexis, pursuant to the accused's plea, of domestic violence. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge awarded no punishment.
5 Dec 23 4	MCRD San Diego	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Recruit Depot San Diego, a military judge convicted Sgt F. Gudiel, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of battery, maltreatment of subordinates, and violating a lawful general order. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to reduction to E-1.
6 Dec 23 5	3d MLG	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Recruit Depot San Diego, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
11 Dec 23 6	HQBN, MCB Hawaii	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal J. D. Hernandez, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of domestic violence. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 12 months of confinement, forfeitures of \$1,278 per month for 12 months, and reduction to E-1.
12 Dec 23 7	HQSvcBn, MCRD Parris Island	At a Special Court-Martial at Marine Corps Recruit Depot, Parris Island, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal J. Z. Soto, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of larceny. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to reduction to E-1.
13 Dec 23 8	MCAF, MCB Quantico	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Quantico, a military judge convicted Corporal Z. M. Zavadil, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of attempting to receive and view child pornography and sexual abuse of a child not involving sexual contact. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge

		sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 12 months confinement, total forfeitures, and a reduction to E-1.
15 Dec 23 9	1st DSB	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Corporal K. N. Burge, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of wire fraud and larceny. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 3 months confinement, forfeitures of \$1,000 per month for 6 months, and reduction to E-1.
18 Dec 23 10	II MIG	At a special court-martial on Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
