SUBJECT: Evaluation of the Accountability of PDA Defense Equipment Deliveries to Ukraine  
(Project No. D2024-DEV0PD-0090.000)

The purpose of this memorandum is to notify you that we plan to begin this evaluation in February 2024. The objective of the evaluation is to determine whether the Defense Security Cooperation Agency (DSCA) and the Military Services are effectively and efficiently accounting for the delivery of Presidential Drawdown Authority (PDA) defense equipment to Ukraine in accordance with DoD property book and DSCA security assistance policy. We may revise the objective as the evaluation proceeds, and we will also consider suggestions from management for additional or revised objectives. We plan to perform this evaluation in accordance with the Council of the Inspectors General on Integrity and Efficiency “Quality Standards for Inspection and Evaluation.”

We will perform the evaluation at multiple locations including Security Assistance Group-Ukraine headquarters in Germany and its subordinate commands in Poland. We may identify additional locations during the evaluation.

We request that you designate a staff member to serve as our point of contact for this evaluation within **5 days** of receipt of this memorandum. The point of contact should be a Government employee—a GS-15, pay band equivalent, or military equivalent—knowledgeable of tracking PDA defense article deliveries to the Government of Ukraine.
