## **Lessons Learned**

**ACCIDENT**: Stepped into Hole

**Date**: 29 Jan 2002

**WHAT HAPPENED:** Worker was moving a 4'X4' piece of plywood form an existing pier hole to a new one being drilled. As he picked up the plywood, he stepped backwards into an 18 inches deep pier hole twisting his ankle and tearing ligaments in his leg.

**CONTRIBUTING FACTORS**: Not paying attention to surrounding work area

**RESULTS**: Twisted ankle and pulled/tore ligament

## **LESSONS LEARNED:**
