SUBJECT: Audit of the Army's Management of Army Prepositioned Stock-4 Equipment (Project No. D2024-D000AH-0077.000)

The purpose of this memorandum is to notify you that we plan to begin the subject audit in January 2024. The objective of this audit is to determine whether the Army effectively managed the execution of storage, maintenance, and accountability for Army Prepositioned Stock-4 in accordance with Federal and DoD requirements. We may revise the objective as the audit proceeds, and we will also consider suggestions from management for additional or revised objectives. We plan to perform this audit in accordance with the Government Accountability Office's generally accepted government auditing standards.

We will perform the audit at Camp Carroll, South Korea. We may identify additional locations during the audit.

We request that you designate a staff member to serve as our point of contact for this audit within 5 days of this memorandum. The point of contact should be a Government employee—a GS-15, pay band equivalent, or military equivalent—and knowledgeable of Army Prepositioned Stock-4 related to the objective. Send the contact's name, title, grade/pay band, phone number, and email address to audacs@dodig.mil.
