SUBJECT: Evaluation of the DoD's Implementation of Combined Joint All-Domain Command and Control Strategy (Project No. D2024-DEV0SI-0130.000)

The purpose of this memorandum is to notify you that we plan to begin the subject evaluation in July 2024.

The objective of this evaluation is to assess the effectiveness with which the DoD developed and implemented the Combined Joint All-Domain Command and Control (CJADC2) line of effort to modernize mission partner information sharing. We may revise the objective as the evaluation proceeds, and we will also consider suggestions from management for additional or revised objectives. We plan to perform this evaluation in accordance with the Council of the Inspectors General on Integrity and Efficiency "Quality Standards for Inspection and Evaluation."

We will perform the evaluation with the relevant offices within the Office of the Under Secretary of Defense for Research and Engineering, DoD Chief Information Officer, Joint Staff, Air Force Mission Partner Capabilities Office, Air Force Advanced Battle Management System, Army Project Convergence, Navy Project Overmatch, U.S. European Command, U.S. Central Command, and U.S. Indo-Pacific Command. We may identify additional locations during the evaluation.

We request that you designate two staff members to serve as our points of contact for this evaluation within **5 days** of this memorandum. The points of contact should be Government employees—pay band or military equivalent of a member of the Senior Executive Service and a GS-15—who are knowledgeable of the CJADC2 line of effort for mission partner information sharing.
