SUBJECT: Audit of the Department of Defense's FY 2024 Compliance with Payment Integrity Information Act Requirements (Project No. D2024-D000FL-0156.000)

The purpose of this memorandum is to notify you that we plan to begin the subject audit in July 2024. This audit is required by Public Law 116-117, "Payment Integrity Information Act of 2019," March 2, 2020.

The objective of this audit is to determine whether, in FY 2024, the DoD complied with the Payment Integrity Information Act of 2019. We may revise the objective as the audit proceeds, and we will also consider suggestions from management for additional or revised objectives. We plan to perform this audit in accordance with the Government Accountability Office's generally accepted government auditing standards.

We will perform the audit at the Office of the Under Secretary of Defense (Comptroller)/Chief Financial Officer, DoD; Defense Finance and Accounting Service; and Defense Health Agency. We may identify additional locations during the audit.

We request that you designate two points of contact for this audit within **5 days** of this memorandum. The points of contact should be Government employees—pay band or military equivalent of a member of the Senior Executive Service and a GS-15—who are knowledgeable of the payment integrity process related to the objective. Send each contact's name, title, grade/pay band, phone number, and email address to <a href="mailto:audfmr@dodig.mil">audfmr@dodig.mil</a>.
