We plan to perform this evaluation in accordance with the Council of the Inspectors General on Integrity and Efficiency “Quality Standards for Inspections and Evaluations.”

We will perform the evaluation at the Office of the Under Secretary of Defense for Research and Engineering. We may identify additional agencies or organizations during the evaluation.

We request that you designate two staff members to serve as our points of contact for the evaluation within 5 days of the date of this memorandum. The points of contact should be Government employees – pay band or military equivalent of a member of the Senior Executive Service and a GS-15. Send each contact’s name, title, grade/pay band, phone number, and email address to [REDACTED] and [REDACTED].
