4 Jan 24 1	2d MarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Staff Sergeant S. Davila, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of attempted sexual abuse of a child and possession of child pornography. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused a dishonorable discharge, 49 months confinement, total forfeitures, and reduction to E-1.
5 Jan 24 2	1st CEB, 1st MarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Sergeant E. L. Savage, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of domestic violence. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 8 months confinement, and reduction to E-3.
10 Jan 24 3	SOI-West, Trng Cmd	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal J. R. Martinez, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of battery and communicating a threat. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge and 3 months confinement.
16 Jan 24 4	10th Mar, 2d MarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal A. J. Leighton, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of battery. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused 53 days confinement and reduction to E-1.
18 Jan 24 5	7 ESB, 1 MLG	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
18 Jan 24 6	HQBN, MCAGCC 29 Palms	At an Art. 16(c) (2) (A) special court-martial at Marine Corps Air Ground Combat Center Twentynine Palms, a military judge acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
23 Jan 24 7	MCSFB, Kings Bay, GA	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Recruit Depot, Parris Island, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal R. V. Beltz, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of battery. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 45 days confinement, and reduction to E-1.
23 Jan 24 8	HMLAT-303, 3D MAW	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Miramar, a military judge convicted Staff Sergeant E. Garcia, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of failure to obey a lawful order and domestic violence. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 5 months confinement, and reduction to E-1.

24 Jan 24 9	MWHS-3, 3D MAW	At an Art. 16(c)(2)(A) special court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Miramar, a military judge acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
24 Jan 24 10	2d MarDiv	At an Art. 16(c)(2)(A) special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
24 Jan 24 11	MACS-2	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Recruit Depot, Parris Island, a military judge convicted Sergeant A. J. Smith, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of domestic violence and battery. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 135 days confinement and reduction to E-1.
25 Jan 24 12	1st MLG	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Sergeant T. W. Donovan, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of possession of child pornography. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 24 months confinement, and reduction to E-1.
30 Jan 24 13	1st MarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Corporal V. A. Deleonvidal, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of indecent recording and domestic violence. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 18 months confinement, and reduction to E-1.
30 Jan 24 14	3d MarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a military judge convicted First Sergeant W. L. Glover, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of Battery. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 30 days confinement and reduction to E-5.
