5 Mar 24	2/11, 1st MarDiv	At an Art. 16(c)(2)(A) special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Corporal S. Davis of battery. The military judge sentenced the accused to forfeitures of \$1,000 per month for 2 months and reduction to E-1.
6 Mar 24	7th ESB	At an Art. 16(c)(2)(A) special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
6 Mar 24	MCB Hawaii	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a military judge convicted Staff Sergeant J. T. Hale, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of rape of a child; sexual abuse of a child; soliciting an offense; indecent language; production of child pornography; and possession of child pornography. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 30 years confinement, total forfeitures, and reduction to E-1.
7 Mar 24	2/8, 2d MarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal D. R. Maragh, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of violating a lawful General Order, reckless driving, misappropriation of property, and burglary. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 3 months confinement and reduction to E-1.
8 Mar 24	VMX-1, MCAS Yuma	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Yuma, a military judge convicted Staff Sergeant J. W. Stark, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of domestic violence. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 90 days confinement, and reduction to E-1.
13 Mar 24	3d MLR, 3d MarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal M. K. Frazier, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of conspiracy and larceny. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 18 months confinement, total forfeitures, and reduction to E-1.
13 Mar 24	1st MAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Foster, a panel of members convicted Staff Sergeant T. K. Williams of battery and communicating a threat. The panel of members sentenced the accused to 3 months confinement, 3 months hard labor, 2 months restriction to base, and a letter of reprimand.
14 Mar 24	MCI-W	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Private C. F. Knaide VI, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of committing a sexual act with an animal. Consistent

		with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge and 33 months confinement.
15 Mar 24	MCAS Cherry Point	Following the previous conviction of Lance Corporal C. I. Marin at a general court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Cherry Point for attempted sexual assault, the appellate court remanded the accused's case for a retrial. At the retrial, a military judge acquitted Lance Corporal C. I. Marin of all charges and specifications.
18 Mar 24	MCI-W	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
19 Mar 24	SOI-E	At a special court-martial on Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
21 Mar 24	1/1, 1st MarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Private First Class A. Martinez, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of drunk driving. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to forfeitures of \$1,000 per month for 12 months and reduction to E-1.
25 Mar 24	3d MAW	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Miramar, a military judge convicted Corporal G. K. Tedrick, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of larceny of military property. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 30 days confinement and reduction to E-1.
26 Mar 24	MCRD PI	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Recruit Depot Parris Island, a military judge convicted Sergeant A. D. Logan Jr., pursuant to the accused's pleas, of maltreatment of subordinates. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 6 months confinement, forfeitures of \$1,344 per month for 12 months, and reduction to E-1.
26 Mar 24	MCRD PI	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Recruit Depot Parris Island, a military judge convicted Private J. K. McCord, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of communicating a threat, failing to obey an order, and obstruction of justice. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad-conduct discharge and 23 months confinement.
28 Mar 24	I MEF	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a panel of members convicted Staff Sergeant J. P. PincolicGonzalez of battery. The panel of members sentenced the accused to a reprimand.
28 Mar 24	3d MAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal J. A. Torres, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of production and attempted possession of child pornography. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 7 months confinement, and reduction to E-1.

29 Mar 24	3d MAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Miramar, a military judge convicted Private D. M. Feist, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of possession, use, distribution, and introduction of controlled substances, and conspiracy. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 96 months of confinement, and total forfeitures.
29 Mar 24	9th MCD	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Miramar, a military judge convicted Staff Sergeant C. D. Ice, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of violating a lawful general order, abuse of position as a military recruiter, and extramarital sexual conduct. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge.
