SUBJECT: Audit of Storage for U.S. Army Prepositioned Stocks in Belgium and
the Netherlands (Project No. D2024-D000RH-0124.000)

The purpose of this memorandum is to notify you that we plan to begin the subject audit in June 2024. The objective of this audit is to assess the effectiveness of the Army's storage of prepositioned stocks in Belgium and the Netherlands (APS-2). We may revise the objective as the audit proceeds, and we will also consider suggestions from management for additional or revised objectives. We plan to perform this audit in accordance with the Government Accountability Office's generally accepted government auditing standards.

We will perform the audit at Army prepositioned stock sites in Belgium and the Netherlands. We may identify additional locations during the audit.

We request that you designate a staff member to serve as our point of contact for this audit within **5 days** of this memorandum. The point of contact should be a Government employee—a GS-15, pay band equivalent, or military equivalent—and knowledgeable of the storage for APS-2 related to the objective. Send the contact's name, title, grade/pay band, phone number, and email address to audrgo@dodig.mil.
