Join this once-in-a-lifetime opportunity and participate in a dive as a Mission Specialist, where you will actively assist in the oceanographic research survey of the Tongue of the Ocean in the Great Bahama Bank. Your participation in this research allows for a rare opportunity to actively engage with a renowened research team to seek answers of this biodiverse hotspot.

OceanGate Expeditions will dive to 487 meters (1,600 feet), depths far beyond the reach of SCUBA to conduct research on sharks, whales, and other deep marine biology as well as nearby shipwrecks. This remarkable, protected area is home to an abundance of rare and unique sea creatures including Cuvier's and Blainville's beaked whales, deep-dwelling sharks and historic shipwrecks.

The expedition will be conducted in 2022. The individual mission support fee of \$25,000 allows us to dive on sites of scientific importance and include a subject matter expert on every dive.

Limited space is available for explorers and adventurers to join the crew of the Tongue of the Ocean Expedition. OceanGate Expeditions will conduct one week of dives to explore this underwater national treasure and we hope you will join us.
