SIXTH FIVE-YEAR REVIEW  
FOR FORMER NAVAL AIR STATION  
BRUNSWICK, MAINE**



The United States Naval Facilities Engineering Systems Command Base Realignment and Closure Program Management Office (NAVFAC BRAC PMO), in conjunction with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) and the Maine Department of Environmental Protection (MEDEP), is conducting a Sixth Five-Year Review for the Former Naval Air Station (NAS) Brunswick, located in Brunswick, Maine. The purpose of the Five-Year Review is to ensure that the selected remedies are effectively protecting human health and the environment as intended.

Under the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act (also known as Superfund), reviews of long-term remedial actions are required every five years to verify continued protection of human health and the environment until sites are deemed suitable for unlimited use and unrestricted exposure. The Navy completed and signed the last Five-Year Review on September 29, 2020.
