SUBJECT: Audit of the DoD's Oversight of Contractor Performance for the F-35 Joint Strike Fighter Sustainment Contracts (Project No. D2024-D000AT-0173.000)

The purpose of this memorandum is to notify you that we are initiating the subject audit. The objective of this audit is to assess the DoD's oversight of contractor performance on air vehicle sustainment contracts for the F-35 Joint Strike Fighter aircraft. We may revise the objective as the audit proceeds, and we will also consider suggestions from management for additional or revised objectives. We plan to perform this audit in accordance with the Government Accountability Office's generally accepted government auditing standards.

We will perform the audit at the Office of the Under Secretary of Defense for Acquisition and Sustainment, Washington, D.C.; Defense Contract Management Agency, Fort Worth, Texas; and the F-35 Joint Program Offices. We will also perform the audit at select Marine Corps, Navy, and Air Force facilities where F-35 Joint Strike Fighter aircraft are located. We will identify additional locations during the audit.

We request that you designate two points of contact for this audit within **5 days** of this memorandum. One point of contact should be a Government employee—a GS-15, pay band equivalent, or military equivalent—who is knowledgeable of the F-35 air vehicle sustainment contracts. The second point of contact should be a member of the Senior Executive Service or a General/Flag Officer who is familiar with the sustainment contracts and could serve as a point of engagement with DoD Office of Inspector General senior leaders, if necessary.
