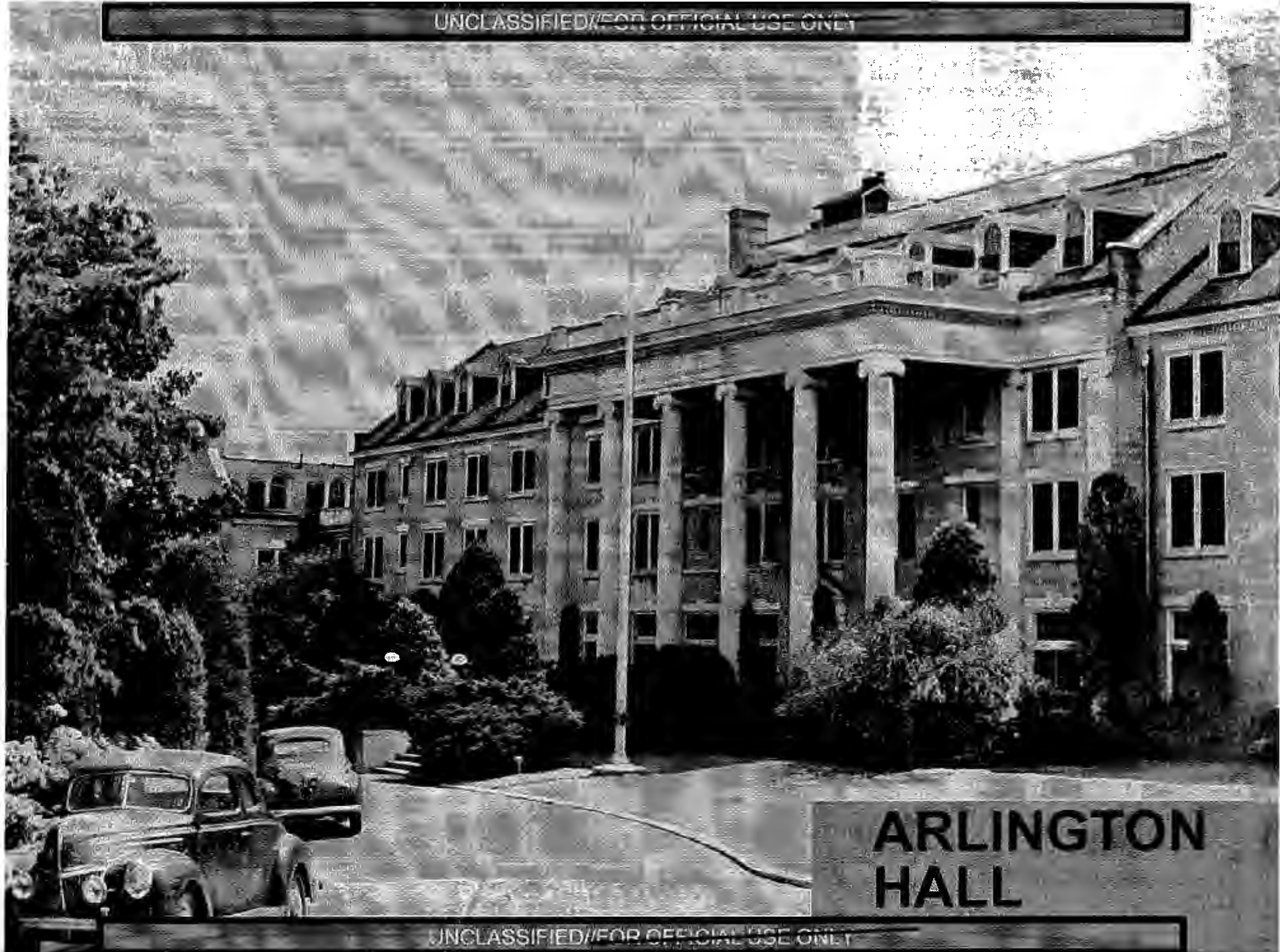

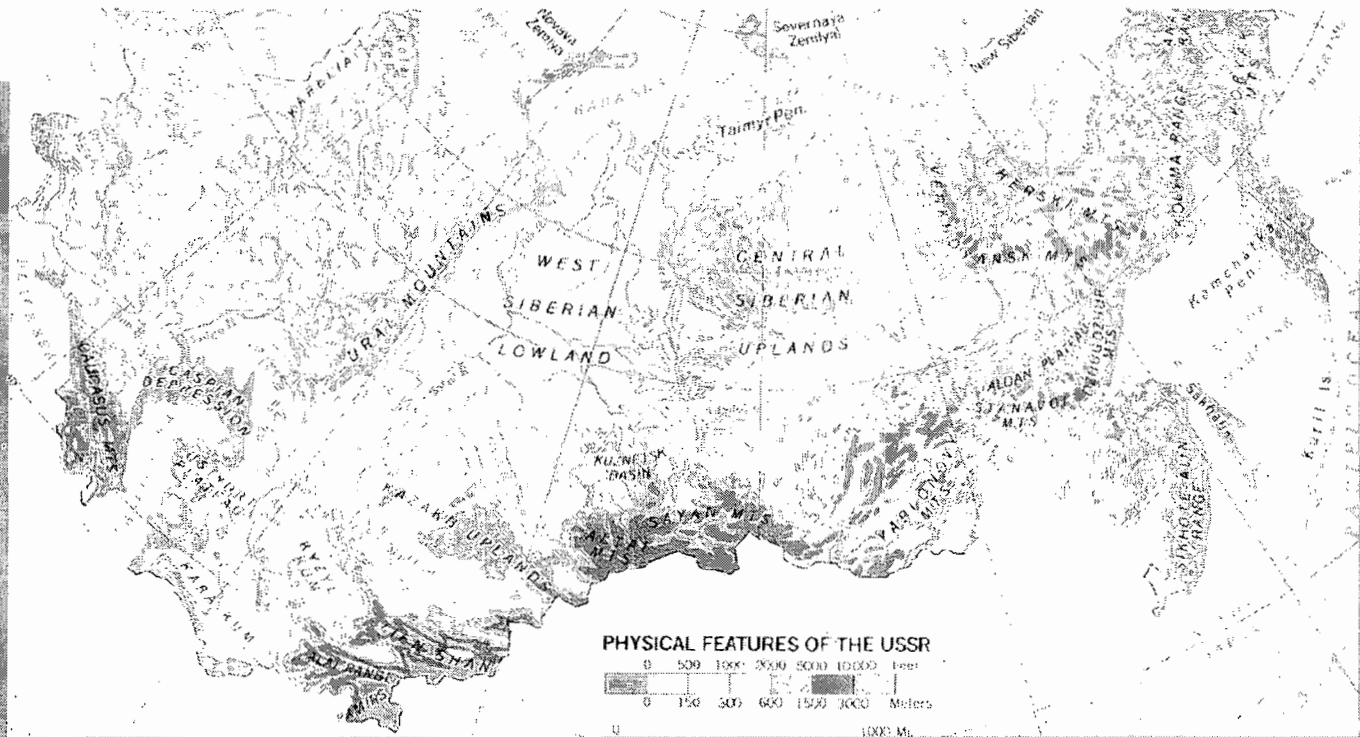

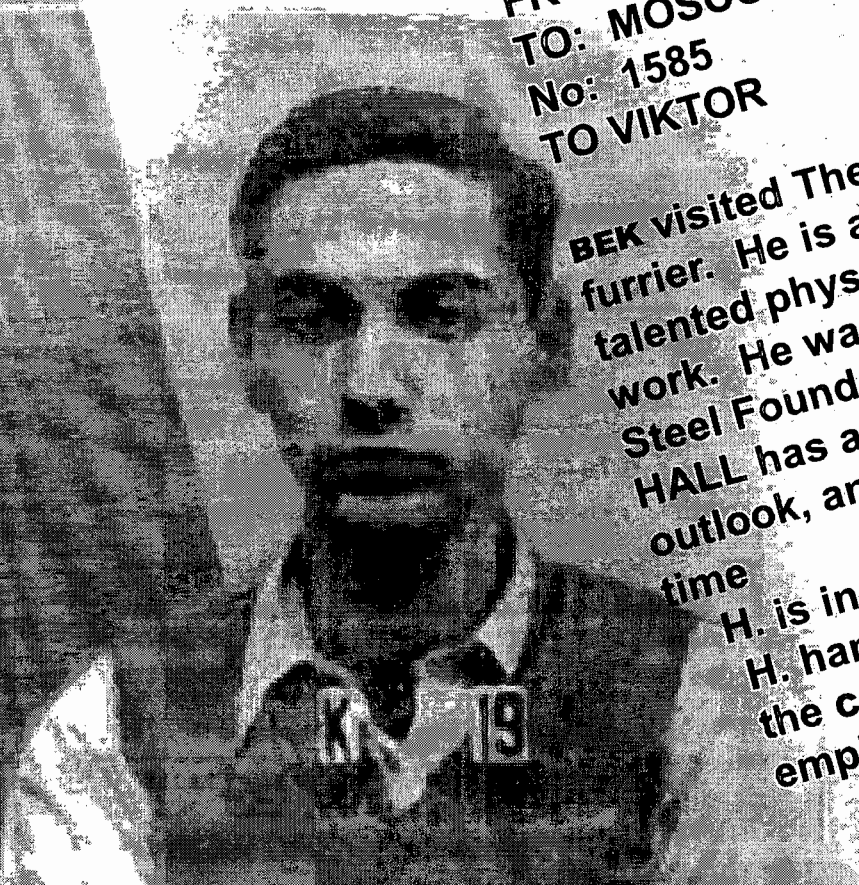

ALES

30 March 1945

- 1. ALES has been working with the NEIGHBORS continuously since 1935.
- 2. For some years past he has been the leader of a small group of the NEIGHBORS' PROBATIONERS, for the most part consisting of his relations.
- The group and ALES himself work on obtaining military information only. Materials on the BANK allegedly interest the NEIGHBORS very little....
- 6. After the Yalta Conference, when he had gone on to Moscow, a Soviet personage in a very responsible position (ALES gave to understand that it was Comrade Vishinsky) allegedly got in touch with ALES and at the behest of the military NEIGHBORS passed on to him their gratitude and so on."

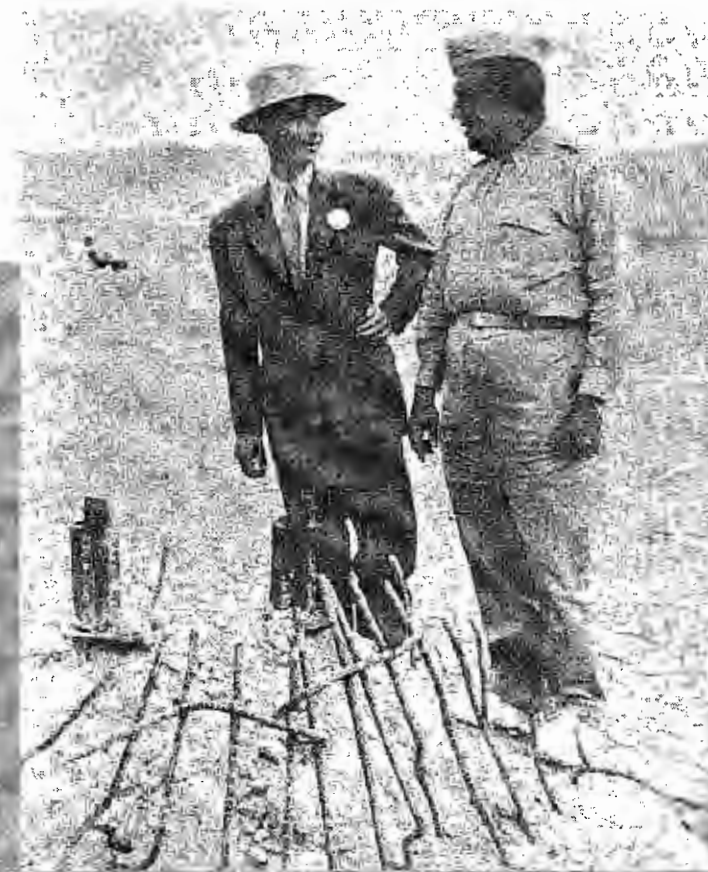
