SUBJECT: Evaluation of the Navy's Future Sailor Preparatory Course  
(Project No. D2025-DEV0HA-0089.000)

The purpose of this memorandum is to notify you that we are initiating the subject evaluation.

The objective of this evaluation is to determine whether the U.S. Navy's Future Sailor Preparatory Course effectively prepared participants to meet or exceed minimum DoD enlistment standards. We may revise the objective as the evaluation proceeds, and we will also consider suggestions from management for additional or revised objectives. We plan to perform this evaluation in accordance with the Council of the Inspectors General on Integrity and Efficiency, "Quality Standards for Inspection and Evaluation."

We will perform the evaluation at the Navy Recruit Training Command, Naval Station Great Lakes. We may identify additional locations during the evaluation.

We request that you designate two points of contact for this evaluation within **5 days** of this memorandum. One point of contact should be a Government employee—a GS-15, pay band equivalent, or military equivalent—who is knowledgeable on the Navy's Future Sailor Preparatory Course. The second point of contact should be a member of the Senior Executive Service or a General/Flag Officer who is familiar with the program and could serve as a point of engagement with DoD Office of Inspector General senior leaders, if necessary.
