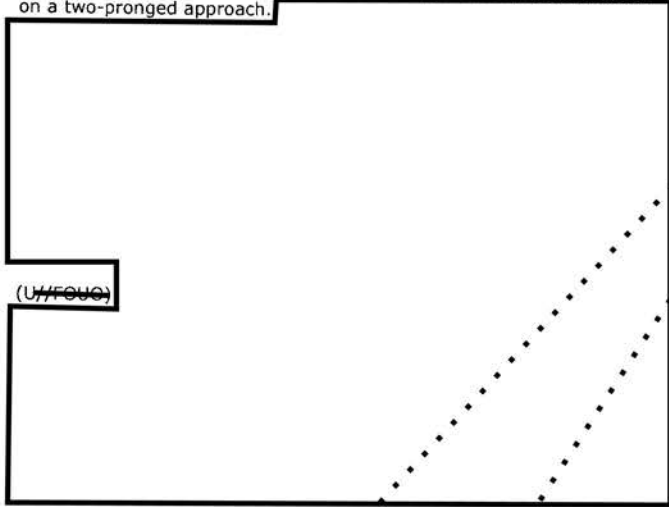

(U//FOUO) Last month (in DIRgram-354), I talked about how our relationship with the National Geospatial-Intelligence Agency (NGA) is steadily advancing. We continue to make significant progress. Following the July 2004 NSA/NGA quarterly meeting, NGA Director Clapper and I commissioned a joint Integrated Project Team (IPT) to develop options to improve collaboration, enable co-production, and increase the number of integrated analysts within each other's space.
