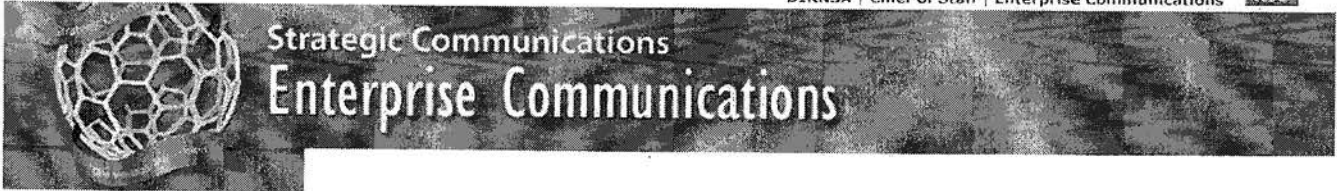

(U//FOUO) Four years ago, I established the NSA/CSS Corporate Strategies Office to build and manage our relations with the private sector. This highly successful effort dramatically expanded both the breadth and the depth of our relations with industry, and many "strategic" relationships have matured into close working-level partnerships with SID and IAD.

(U//FOUO) This process, one of the key elements of the Transformation 2.0 initiative, continues to expand at an unprecedented rate. Our success in this area presents us with the challenge and opportunity of leveraging a range of industrial relationships spanning the strategic to the nuts-and-bolts tactical.

(U//FOUO) Toward this end, today I am announcing the creation of a third DIRNSA center (the others are the National Security Operations Center and the [redacted] - the NSA/CSS Commercial Solutions Center - to integrate the full range of our industrial relationships. I've asked [redacted] to lead this new center. The organization will fold together the activities of our current Corporate Strategy Office with the appropriate activities within the mission and support directorates that foster and manage outcomes from our relations with industry. [redacted] will provide a plan of action and milestones for my approval by 28 January.
