Mandatory Requirements*

1. Must have a current Top Secret SCI security clearance
2. Must have a current counterintelligence polygraph (within 7 years)
3. Must have a Service and Duty Section Approval
4. Must participate a minimum of 90 days
5. Resume and military career data brief
6. Completed questionnaire (page 2 of this document)

*Unfortunately, we are unable to accept applications for those members who do not currently meet items 1 and 2 of the above requirements, as we do not have the funding or capacity to complete the required security processing within the period of the program. Additionally, National Guard and Reservists at NSA are not eligible to participate in the NSA SkillBridge program.
