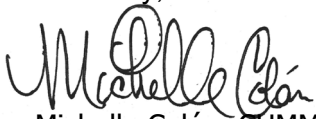
Resolution Consultants, on behalf of the United States Department of Navy, is pleased to distribute the following interview questionnaire to the public regarding the remedial activities that have occurred at Nomans Land Island during the First Five-Year Review (FYR) period from November 2021 through November 2026.

Under the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act (CERCLA) §121 (c), if a remedial action results in CERCLA hazardous substances, pollutants or contaminants remaining at a site at levels that do not allow for unlimited use and unrestricted exposure, the site must be reviewed every five years. The Department of the Navy, in cooperation with the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) and the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP), has begun the First FYR of the remedy selected at Nomans Land Island. The goal of FYR is to evaluate the implementation and performance of the remedy to determine if the remedy is and will continue to be protective of human health and the environment.

This questionnaire is being provided to the USFWS, MassDEP, Wampanoag Tribe of Aquinnah and the Town Administrators and citizens of Aquinnah and Chilmark, MA. Your response is requested to gauge community knowledge and concerns regarding the status of the implemented remedy.
