SUBJECT: Follow-up Evaluation on Artificial Intelligence Recommendations  
(Project No. D2026-DEV0SI-0108.000)

The purpose of this memorandum is to notify you that the DoW Office of Inspector General is initiating the subject follow-up evaluation.\*

The objective of this evaluation is to determine the status of open recommendations related to the DoW's implementation of artificial intelligence policy and procedures from the following evaluations.

- DODIG-2023-116, "Evaluation of the Department of Defense Intelligence Agencies' Use of Human Language Technology," August 21, 2023 (Report is Classified)
- DODIG-2025-039, "Evaluation of the Effectiveness of the Chief Digital and Artificial Intelligence Office's Artificial Intelligence Governance and Acquisition Process," November 14, 2024
- DODIG-2025-172, "Management Advisory: Evaluation of the DoD's Development and Implementation of Quantum Technologies," September 25, 2025
- DODIG-2026-040, "Management Advisory: Evaluation of the DoD's Development and Implementation of Quantum Technologies," January 8, 2026
- DODIG-2026-055, "Joint Evaluation of the National Geospatial-Intelligence Agency's Integration of Maven," February 10, 2026 (Report is Classified)

We may revise the objective as the follow-up evaluation proceeds and we will consider suggestions from management for additional or revised objectives. We plan to perform this evaluation in accordance with the Council of the Inspectors General on Integrity and Efficiency "Quality Standards for Inspection and Evaluation."


We request that you designate two points of contact for this review within **5 days** of this memorandum. One point of contact should be a government employee—a GS-15, pay band equivalent, or military equivalent—who is knowledgeable of the applicable cited reports and DoW’s artificial intelligence policy and procedures. The second point of contact should be a member of the Senior Executive Service or a General/Flag Officer and could serve as a point of engagement with DoW Office of Inspector General senior leaders, if necessary.
