<b>WHY IS WORK BEING DONE?</b>	The Navy is collecting soil samples to determine the potential presence of post-non-time critical removal action (NTCRA) surface contamination within SWDA Westside.
<b>WHAT WILL BE DONE?</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Soil samples will be collected up to 1.5 feet below ground surface using a hand-driven auger or shovel.</li> <li>• No heavy machinery or dust control measures will be required to complete this work.</li> <li>• No waste will be generated.</li> </ul>
<b>WHERE WILL IT BE DONE?</b>	Work will be performed within the fenced area that encompasses SWDA Westside. See attached figure for the location of this investigation.
<b>HOW WILL IT IMPACT RESIDENTS?</b>	Limited impact to residents is anticipated. Noise associated with worker passenger vehicles may be present. All work will be performed between 8:00 AM and 5:00 PM
