GENTEXT/REMARKS/1. Per ref A, all ships present, activities, and installations within the Southwest Region Area of Responsibility will shift to the Summer Uniform per the following schedule:

a. Zone 1 - This zone includes warm climate areas, which will shift to the Summer Uniform at 0001L, Monday, 6 April 2026. This zone is defined as the states of Arizona (except from Phoenix to Tucson), New Mexico, and California south of interstate 80 with the exceptions of Monterey and San Francisco County. Phoenix to Tucson are included in Zone 3 due to their warmer climate. Monterey and San Francisco County are included in Zone 2 due to their cooler climate.

b. Zone 2 - This zone includes cooler climate areas, which will shift to the Summer Uniform at 0001L, Monday, 4 May 2026. This zone is defined as the states of Nevada, Colorado, Utah, and California north of interstate 80. Monterey and San Francisco are south of interstate 80, but are included in Zone 2.

c. Zone 3 - This Zone includes warmer climate areas, which will shift to the Summer Uniform at 0001L, Monday, 2 March 2026. This Zone is defined as Southern Arizona from Phoenix to Tucson and includes Naval Air Facility El Centro.

2. Uniform of the day:

- a. Officer/Chief Petty Officer
  - (1) Prescribed: Service Dress White
  - (2) Alternative: Summer White or Service Khaki
- b. E-1 through E-6
  - (1) Prescribed: Service Dress White
  - (2) Alternate: Service Uniform

3. Requests for exception to policy must be submitted in writing to Commander, Navy Region Southwest via e-mail to the Region Command Master Chief.//
